Change to MLP Flatpack series mounting tab bracket

This notice is to inform our customers of a change to our MLP Flatpack series mounting tab bracket.

Since introducing this series roughly 20 years ago, we have offered a welded mounting tab flange as a standard option. To improve the efficiency of our manufacturing methods, we have recently developed, and thoroughly tested, MLP Flatpack capacitors made with a tab that is drawn and stamped into the case. We have several large military/aerospace contractors who are already using this new tab construction.

The integrated tab will be adopted as our standard mounting tab option for our MLP series. From a dimensional standpoint, the new tab fits within the same footprint as the welded tab, and has the same mounting-hole size and location as the welded tab. The integrated tab has a radius rather than square edges and, while it appears different, fits into the footprint of the rectangular welded tab.

Starting April 1st 2016, all new orders for standard MLP part numbers with mounting tabs will be manufactured with the integrated tab. There will be no change to the part number.

Attached you will find a copy of our case/tab specification, along with a list of purchased parts that will be subjected to this change.
